NAME OF CONFIRMATION CANDIDATE:

1. We believe that Christians are called to serve God and our neighbors. Confirmation Class of 2018 Candidates (Confirmation II) will complete a minimum of 4 "Service Events" to help prepare them for lives of service. 2. Candidates will attend and participate in the Rite of Welcoming at the 9 a.m. mass on November 19, 2017
3. Supporting you as your child's first and primary catechists, our diocese requires that at least one parent attend one of our St. Ann Confirmation Parent Classes and at least one parent join us at our St. Ann Confirmation Retreat in Trinity Hall on Saturday afternoon, January 27, 2018.
4. Focusing on the sacrament and on building up our faith community, all Confirmation Candidates will participate in our St. Ann Confirmation Retreat on Saturday, January 27 beginning at 8:15 a.m. mass and concluding after our 4:30 p.m. mass in our St. Ann Church. Candidates will attend and participate in the Rite of Enrollment during the 4:30 p.m. mass.
5. Any candidate unable to attend our all-day retreat on January 27 will need to find and attend another all-day confirmation retreat.
6. Growing spiritually on this journey will be greatly supported and invigorated by regular participation in Mass and celebration of Reconciliation. Parents will provide for their candidates to participate in weekly Sunday Mass and will provide for them to celebrate Reconciliation at least once in Advent and again in Lent. Both SAS and PRE will announce dates for Reconciliation.
7. Candidates will attend and participate in the Rite of Sending at the 5 p.m. mass on the Sunday prior to our scheduled date for Confirmation (TBA).
8. Candidates will exhibit their preparedness through participating in either, or both: Candidate/Catechist Interview and/or Written Assessment as determined by catechist.
9. To properly prepare the candidates, it is required that PRE Confirmation II students participate in their full PRE class as scheduled. Five excused absences are allowed. Our school students are required to adhere to the attendance and participation policies set forth by SACS.
10. Reflecting modesty, respect and reverence in our appearance as we celebrate Confirmation, candidates agree to abide by the Dress Requirement guidelines set forth.
